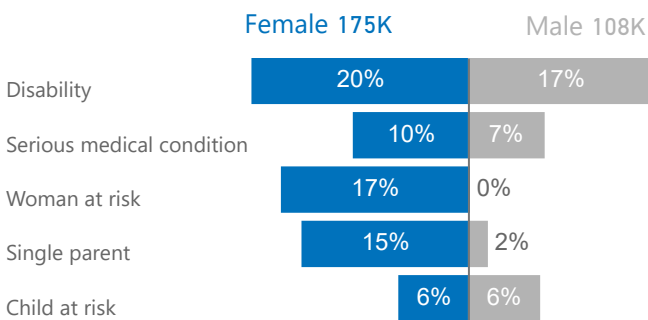
Population by settlement



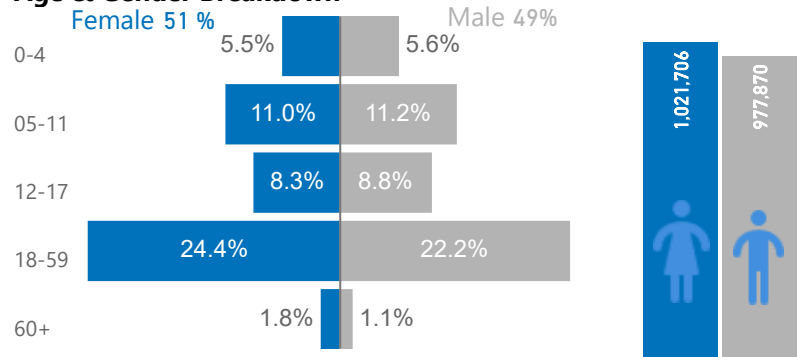
New arrival registration trend (last 6 months)

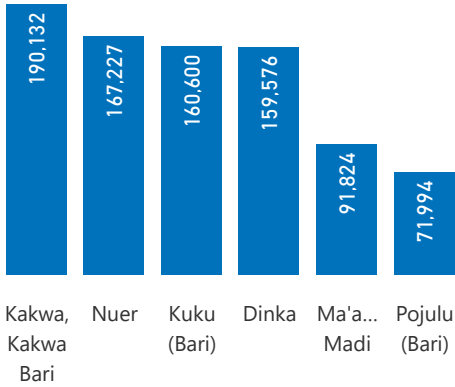
Since the start of the year, 22,474 individuals seeking asylum, including 9,671 from Eritrea, 5,761 from South Sudan, 4,217 from the DR Congo, and 1,656 from Sudan have been registered in Uganda. 7,746 new births were also registered during the year. In total the population increased by 12,762 individuals (1%) from last month. Since the start of the conflict in Sudan in Mid-April 2023, 90,484 Sudanese fleeing the conflict have been registered in Uganda. There are currently 657,223 registered DR Congolese in Uganda, up 95,343 since end 2024.



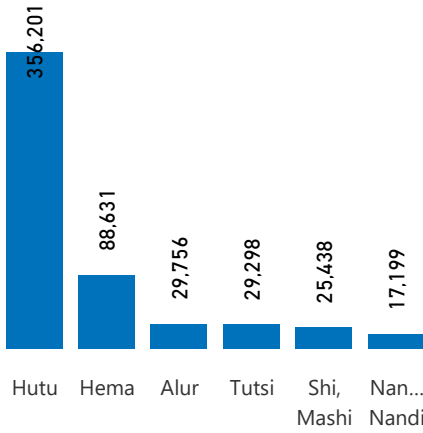
UGANDA - OVERVIEW OF REFUGEES AND ASYLUM-SEEKERS

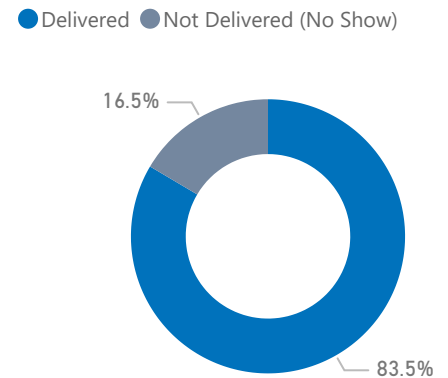
Main South Sudanese Ethnicities



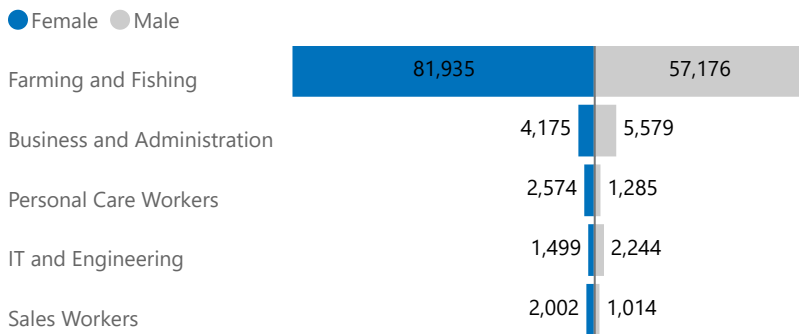
Main Congolese Ethnicities



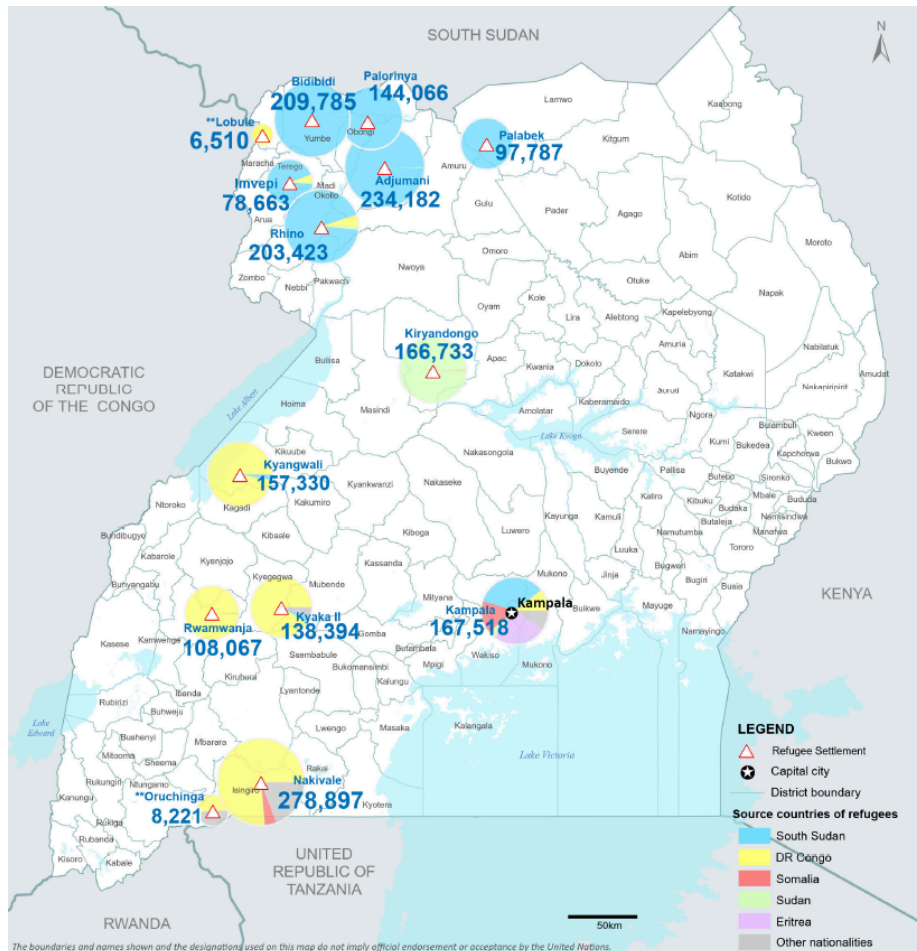
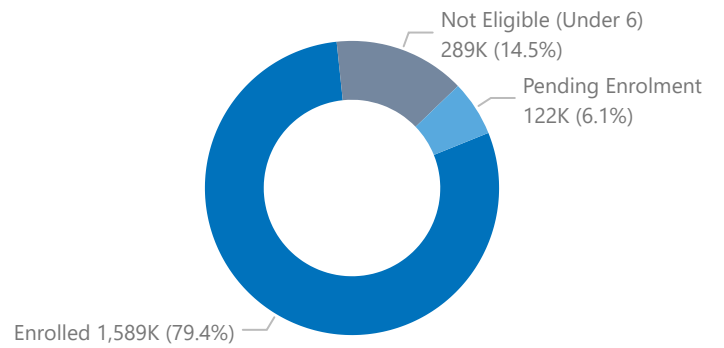
