The target group of the training are project managers of CVA programmes and technical advisors for CVA programming of German-based humanitarian actors and their (local) offices and partners.

Objective

The objective of the training is to increase the understanding of how to apply the IASC Guidelines on the Inclusion of Persons with Disabilities in Humanitarian Action for CVA programming with a specific focus on needs assessment and addressing the specific needs of persons with disabilities.

Methodology

The training will follow a “blended learning” approach which includes online and in-person sessions. The training starts with an online introduction and an online self-learning exercise of around 60 minutes.

The two-day face-to-face workshop in Berlin will include a mix of input presentations, group and scenario working sessions, plenary discussions, and the option for individual advisory sessions. Persons with disabilities will be actively engaged as guest speaker sessions.

Successful applicants are selected based on pre-defined criteria to ensure diversity and facilitate successful exchanges & learning.

The training is free of charge. Necessary transport and hotel for the face-to-face workshop needs to be covered by the participants.
