We would like to invite you to our upcoming two-day seminar on '**Disability-inclusion in the Project Cycle Management in Humanitarian Action**', which will be conducted on the **18 and 19 November 2019 in Berlin**. The seminar is primarily targeting HQ-based project managers and desk officers but also technical advisors of humanitarian organisations.

Persons with disabilities are often not considered part of the general target group in humanitarian response nor in the assessment, management, decision-making and implementation processes of a project. This invisibility during a humanitarian project cycle results in increased discrimination and risk of being excluded from general humanitarian services.

Technical experts will provide relevant basics and give practical examples of approaches and methods to anchor disability inclusion systematically in the humanitarian project cycle management. An in-depth focus lies on inclusive approaches in the assessment phase and M&E activities with inputs from practitioners from the field.
